Music (acoustic - no amps)

Voice: Gregorian chants, Madrigals, Opera, Art Songs, Gilbert & Sullivan, Broadway, jazz, country western. Need a choir.

Trumpet: Bb for solos, C for symphonic and blues, natural (the long kind with no valves) for Baroque. Need a community band.

Computers and electronics (BSEE, MSCS, MBA, Amateur Extra)
